The course is not only for specialists, but also for vets in general practice who would like to expand their range of stifle surgery or try something new. The relevant anatomy, pathology and meniscal examinations will be fully covered. Orthopaedic and surgical experience is an advantage for participants of this course, though not necessary.

### Overview

The tear of the cranial cruciate ligament is still one of the most common orthopaedic injuries in a dog. Frequently, thoughts arise to replace the CrCL anatomically correctly, instead of changing the forces acting in the joint. This course offers you the opportunity to get an overview of newly developed intracapsular technology. In this technique, an artificial band is used as a total replacement for the cranial cruciate ligament using tunnel-tunnel-technique. The structure of the ligament has intraarticularly parallel fibres, just like the natural cruciate ligament. The ligament is fixed in the tibia and Os femoris by means of interference screws in drill channels.

### Speakers
